


How do you get to, from, and around campus?






What days of the week are you on campus?

Campus Physical Framework Vision Project MyCampus Survey



As part of the UO Campus Physical Framework Vision Project, campus planners developed an interactive on-line mapping tool to ask campus community members about the special places they love, places that need work, and how they move about the campus.

The survey was open for two weeks in February 2015 and vielded nearly 1,400 responses – 75% from students. Survey results are being used to evaluate existing conditions, preferences, patterns of use, and movement across campus, as well as to help inform the Framework Vision Project planning process.


