## Campus Planning Committee Annual Report 2023-2024

### Summary of Meetings and Activities

Since Fall 2023, the Campus Planning Committee (CPC) has held 11 meetings and forwarded 8 recommendations to Administration. The committee reviewed numerous campus development projects including the Next Generation Housing Development Plan, the Next Generation Housing New Residence Hall Project Phase 1 and 2 building sitings, the *East Campus Area Plan* and *Campus Plan* amendments, the 2024-26 Biennial Capacity Plan, and a number of additional smaller facility improvement projects, such as the exceptions to the *Campus Plan* Outdoor Sign Plan proposals for signs at a student recreation field, to establish additional approved pole banner locations, for a banner at the Museum of Natural and Cultural History (MNCH), and Senate Bill 554 signage.

Additionally, in 2023-24, the committee reviewed and provided a recommendation for the Bronze “Thinker Duck” statue siting, and reviewed and provided feedback on the 10-year Capital Plan, the UO Long Range Transportation Plan update, the Framework Vision Project retrospective, and the 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue Redesign schematic design check-in.

CPC members served on project user groups for development projects that were initiated this past year. Staff educated the committee about its role in the campus development process and provided relevant background materials to enable well-informed decisions about a wide range of complex campus planning and development issues.
