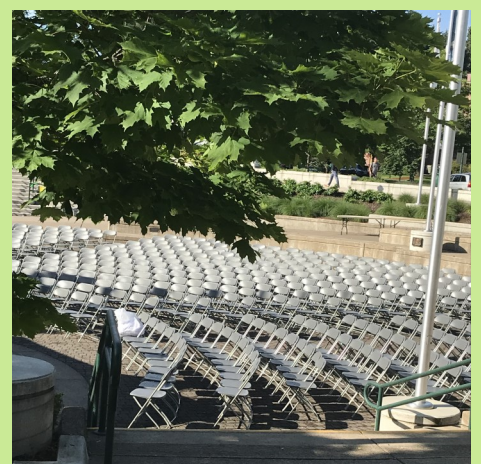

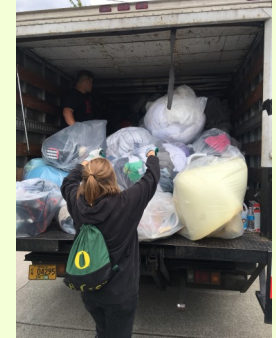
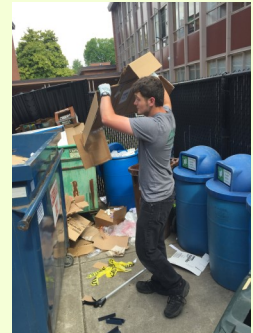
COMMENCEMENT

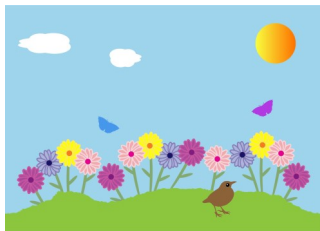

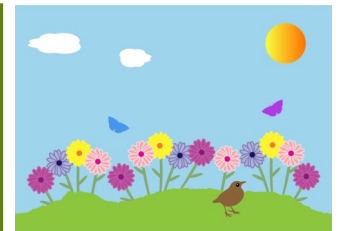
