Campus Plan Amendments

Academics, Student Support, and Administration **Design** Area Two amendments to the Campus Plan were approved by

President Schill in June 2021. The first of these amendments incorporates the university's land southeast of the Jaqua Triangle Design Area into the Campus Plan. This area was

previously not incorporated into the official campus boundary because the land was more recently acquired. The

amendment documents the existing development, bringing this area into the Campus Plan, which will help guide any future changes to the area based on Campus Plan principles. Any exterior changes in the area are now subject to the Campus Plan.
