## 1. 13th Avenue Redesign - Schematic Design Review

<u>Background:</u> The purpose of this agenda item is to review the schematic design for the 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue Redesign project.

As shown in the attached description, the schematic design addresses the half-mile segment of 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Kincaid Street and Agate Street, along with key campus entrances at 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Kincaid Street and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Agate Street.

The project is informed by the Conceptual Design completed in August 2019 led by Walker Macy Landscape Architects. The schematic design establishes a design that will transform 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue into an exceptional pedestrian walking and bicycling experience on the university's primary east-west axis while still allowing limited vehicle access for service and emergencies. The design addresses circulation for all modes, stormwater treatment, street trees, lighting, seating, campus gateways, service vehicles, paving, etc.

The project is only funded through schematic design.

The committee has held two previous meetings regarding this agenda item on October 20, 2023, and June 11, 2024. The previous meeting records are located here:
