Campus Planning Committee Annual Report 2024-2025

Summary of Meetings and Activities

Since Fall 2024, the Campus Planning Committee (CPC) has held 14 meetings and forwarded 15 recommendations to Administration. The committee reviewed numerous campus development projects including the Next Generation Housing New Residence Hall Project Phase 1 Schematic Design, the 13th Avenue Redesign Schematic Design, the Beach Volleyball Court and Storage Building Schematic Design, the Friendly Hall Deferred Maintenance Schematic Design, and a number of additional smaller improvement projects, including the Grove Community Garden Relocation Project, the Earl Hall Window Replacement Project, various exceptions to the *Campus Plan* Outdoor Sign Plan, and the Heritage Project Exterior 1% for Art Siting.

Additionally, in 2024-25, the committee reviewed and provided a recommendation for the *East Campus Area Plan* and *Campus Plan* amendments and provided feedback for the *UO Transportation Plan* update.

Staff educated the committee about its role in the campus development process and provided relevant background materials to enable well-informed decisions about a wide range of complex campus planning and development issues.
