

OPEN SPACE AREA ALONG WILLAMETTE

- Restored riparian area along Willamette, lay back the river bank to more natural slope, implement Riparian Management recommendations
- Promote ecological diversity with enhanced landscapes and native plants
- Opportunities to engage with the river
- Natural areas for education, research, passive recreation
- Bike and pedestrian paths
- Seating areas for contemplation and resting

OUTDOOR ACTIVE RECREATION AREA

- Recreation fields to support active student life and physical education
- Careful attention to environmental context, including stormwater treatment
- Careful attention to minimize lighting impacts

RESTRICTED BUILDING DEVELOPMENT AREA

- Building projects will follow Campus Planning process
- Opportunities for buildings to support environmental research and education
- Buildings to be responsive to environmental context

NOTES

- General location
- Includes all site elements associated with permitted uses in the zone and regulating plan, such as but not limited to landscape, pathways, site furniture, transportation circulation, utilities, and public art.

- Restored riparian edge along Millrace
- Opportunities to engage with Millrace
- Natural areas for education, research, and passive recreation
- Promote ecological diversity with enhanced landscapes and native plants
- Seating areas for contemplation and resting
- New designated open spaces, including along the Willamette River, to be approved by the Campus Planning Committee as an amendment to the Campus Plan
